Discussion Questions

2. Consider a time when you asked the Lord for a specific thing and received a specific “no.” Was it what you expected? How did God work in ways that you may not have seen at the time?
3. In Luke 11, we see the friend’s importunity, or his helpless, urgent consistency. What is an area of your life where you have had to exercise importunity in prayer? What was the result?
